

Fabric Requirements for Roosting Robin of the Month 2009

The fabric selection is very simple. Find a print that you like for the last border - a print that when cut 8 inches finish looks good. This would be a great project to use a border fabric on. The rest of the colors on the quilt come from the border fabric you picked.

- Last Border – 8 strips 8 1/2 inch by at least 40 inches. If you are using a border print then you will have to calculate your yardage accordingly. Mine was just a large print so I cut my pieces width of fabric, but I centered the motif. Therefore, I needed more fabric when fussy cutting the border strips.
- Background - You will need about 2 yards of background fabric. I use the same fabric throughout but that is not necessary. If you are using scraps you will need about 8 pieces 21 inches square.
- The rest of the fabrics are FQs except for the Seminole border, which needs one yard of fabric for the main fabric. These fabrics can be selected as you go.
