


## Roosting Robin of the Month 2009

### Final Round


In the last step of the Roosting Robin we will add the border to each triangle before we sew them to the top.

You have four triangles on which you have appliquéd one fourth of the center design. Cut 8 border strips 8 1/2 inches wide and 40 in long.



Mark a dot 1/4 of an inch from both edges on the 90 degree corner.



Take one border strip and mark 10 inches from the end and sew to the corner triangle from the marked dot to the end of the triangle. Make sure your needle starts at the marked dot on the triangle. Press seam towards the border.




Now do the other side the same way.




Iron the borders out.  
See how the borders overlap  
each other.

Iron back one of the borders to match up with the other border at a 45 degree angle. The ironed crease will be your sewing guide.



Align the two borders right sides together. Starting at the marked dot sew on the ironed line.



When you open up and press the seam open you will have a mitered corner. Make four of these units. Trim the triangle so the hypotenuse is the same length as the side of the center. Mark the center of the unit and sew to each corner of the center and trim seams.
